

On Tuesday, February 19, 2013 at 7:30 p.m. Town Board Chairperson Greg Anderson called the regular monthly Town Board meeting to order. Other Supervisors present were Mark Riverblood, Eugene Stoeckel, Jim Kusler and John Roxbury, Jr.

### **Approve Minutes**

A motion was made by John Roxbury, Jr. and seconded by Eugene Stoeckel to approve the minutes of the January 15, 2013 regular monthly meeting. Motion Carried.

### **Approve Financial Report**

A motion was made by John Roxbury, Jr. and seconded by Jim Kusler to approve the Financial Report for January 2013 as submitted. Beginning Balance of Township funds was \$411,046.68; total receipts of \$2,576.12; total disbursements of \$35,727.49; leaving a balance of \$377,895.31. Motion Carried Unanimously.

### **Old Business**

Jim Kusler explained that the issues involving Baptist Church Road have all been resolved. The City of Princeton only owns a very small portion of the road on the curve and the remainder of the road is Princeton Township. The road will also be posted with the correct ton requirements.

### **New Business**

Greg Anderson explained that he has spoken with Loren Kohlen regarding the construction complaint that was made at 5344 70<sup>th</sup> Ave. There is really no reason that the Township needs to get involved because this is simply an issue between the homeowner and the builder. At the time the home was built, Metro West Inspections enforced the building code that was in place.

Mr. Anderson also stated that Loren reassured him that if the issue is ever brought to court, Mr. Kohlen and his lawyers will be responding to it.

Eugene Stoeckel motioned to approve Resolution 2013-4; Floodplain Management Ordinance with Summary Publication. John Roxbury, Jr. seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

The Town Board reviewed the recommendations from the Planning Commission regarding the Septic Ordinance changes. They agreed to send it to a public hearing at the next Planning Commission meeting.

### **Open Forum**

There were no residents present who wished to speak.

### **Supervisor's Reports**

John Roxbury, Jr. stated that there is no written policy regarding firearms on the premise but he believes that firearms should be allowed. The rest of the Town Board agreed. He stated that he feels the Clerk and the Deputy Clerk should have the option

to protect themselves that way and if they want to get a conceal and carry permit and or training, that the Township would pay for it.

Mark Riverblood motioned to approve that the Township pay for conceal and carry training and a permit, if the Clerk and Deputy Clerk decided to. Eugene Stoeckel seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Eugene Stoeckel gave an update on the Fire Advisory Board.

Jim Kusler gave an update on the City of Princeton's Planning Commission.

Mark Riverblood gave an update on the 4R Board.

**Clerks Business**

The Clerk informed the Board that she will be working on the annual newsletter so if they have anything they want to add, just let her know.

The Clerk informed the Board that she would like to attend the Spring Short Course on March 26<sup>th</sup>. The Board agreed to have her attend.

The Clerk reminded the Board that the Board of Audit meeting will be the following Thursday.
