

On Tuesday, August 20, 2013 at 7:30 p.m. Town Board Chairperson Greg Anderson called the regular monthly Town Board meeting to order. Other Supervisors present were Jim Kusler, Eugene Stoeckel, John Roxbury, Jr. and Mark Riverblood.

Approve Minutes

A motion was made by Eugene Stoeckel and seconded by John Roxbury, Jr. to approve the minutes of the July 16, 2013 regular monthly meeting. Motion Carried.

Approve Financial Report

A motion was made by John Roxbury, Jr. and seconded by Eugene Stoeckel to approve the Financial Report for July 2013 as submitted. Beginning Balance of Township funds was \$274,538.69; total receipts of \$178,720.06; total disbursements of \$24,358.12; leaving a balance of \$428,900.63. Motion Carried Unanimously.

Old Business

There was no old business on the agenda to discuss.

New Business

Eugene Stoeckel motioned to approve the Town Hall payment of \$10,750.00. John Roxbury, Jr. seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

John Roxbury, Jr. motioned to table the discussion regarding Ordinance Changes until everyone has had a little more time to review all of the information. Eugene Stoeckel seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Mark Riverblood stated that he is concerned with the lights on some towers that are causing light pollution and would like to get rid of all the tower lights. He is concerned about new towers coming into the Township and would like to be able to control the lighting that goes on them.

After some discussion, the Clerk was directed to get more information regarding tower heights and lighting.

Open Forum

There were no residents who wished to speak.

Supervisor's Reports

Mark Riverblood gave an update on the 4R Board.

Jim Kusler gave an update on the City of Princeton Planning Commission.

Eugene Stoeckel gave an update on the Airport Advisory Board.

John Roxbury, Jr. stated that the garage on his property was vandalized by gangs and would like for the Clerk to contact the Sheriff's office and have them attend a meeting and give an update on the gangs in the area.

Clerks Business

The Clerk stated that she received a list from Duane Baker for gravel that was needed on the roads. It was a total of 18 loads.

John Roxbury, Jr. motioned to approve having Brian Dahlheimer deliver the gravel since he would also be doing the graveling on 35th. Eugene Stoeckel seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

The Clerk stated that she received a bid for \$1,340.00 from Towns Insulation for the insulating for the Town Hall and that insurance would be covering the loss. The Board agreed to have the insulating done.

Approve Payment of the Bills

A motion was made by Eugene Stoeckel and seconded by John Roxbury, Jr. to approve payment of the bills, Check numbers 10143-10170. Motion Carried.
