

On Tuesday, April 15, 2014 at 7:30 p.m. Town Board Chairperson Greg Anderson called the regular monthly Town Board meeting to order. Other Supervisors present were Eugene Stoeckel, John Roxbury, Jr., Mark Riverblood and Jim Kusler.

Approve Minutes

A motion was made by Eugene Stoeckel and seconded by Mark Riverblood to approve the minutes of the March 25, 2014 regular monthly meeting as printed. Motion Carried.

Approve Financial Report

A motion was made by John Roxbury, Jr. and seconded by Eugene Stoeckel to approve the Financial Report for March 2014 as submitted. Beginning Balance of Township funds was \$397,639.28; total receipts of \$89.81; total disbursements of \$31,645.03; leaving a balance of \$366,084.06. Motion Carried Unanimously.

Old Business

Mark Riverblood motioned to amend the agenda to move up the Presentation for the Upcoming School Referendum. John Roxbury, Jr. seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Lynn Anderson, a representative from the School District, gave a Presentation for the Upcoming School Referendum.

The first item under Old Business was to Review the Ordinances re Land Splits – tabled from last month. John Roxbury, Jr. suggested having the Planning Commission take another look at it. Eugene Stoeckel stated that when a hardship is referred to under the Resolution Exemption, he would like to require the applicant to actually state what the hardship is.

John Roxbury, Jr. motioned to have the Planning Commission take another look at the Ordinance Issues regarding land splits. Mark Riverblood seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

The next item under Old Business was a Discussion on the Tax Forfeited Property in the Township, from the previous month. After some discussion, the Town Board decided to take no action on the properties and let the County get the parcels back into the tax roll.

Eugene Stoeckel motioned to take no action on the tax forfeited properties. John Roxbury, Jr. seconded the motion. Motion Carried. Mark Riverblood abstained from voting because he missed the discussion regarding these properties at the last meeting.

New Business

John Roxbury, Jr. motioned to approve the Liquor Licenses for the following establishments:

- Long Siding Bar & Grill

Eugene Stoeckel seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Carol Carling gave an update on the Princeton Area Visionary Committee.

John Roxbury, Jr. stated that the County has their GIP mapping system available online.

Eugene Stoeckel gave an update on the Airport and Fire Advisory Board.

Mark Riverblood gave an update on the 4R Board.

A motion was made by John Roxbury, Jr. and seconded by Eugene Stoeckel to approve payment of the bills, Check numbers 10386-10411. Motion Carried.
