

On Tuesday, June 17, 2014 at 7:30 p.m. Town Board Chairperson Greg Anderson called the regular monthly Town Board meeting to order. Other Supervisors present were Eugene Stoeckel, John Roxbury, Jr., Mark Riverblood and Jim Kusler.

Approve Minutes

A motion was made by Eugene Stoeckel and seconded by John Roxbury, Jr. to approve the minutes of the May 20, 2014 regular monthly meeting as printed. Motion Carried.

Approve Financial Report

A motion was made by John Roxbury, Jr. and seconded by Eugene Stoeckel to approve the Financial Report for May 2014 as submitted. Beginning Balance of Township funds was \$350,072.58; total receipts of \$2,282.87; total disbursements of \$22,442.07; leaving a balance of \$329,913.38. Motion Carried Unanimously.

Old Business

John Roxbury, Jr. motioned to have the Planning Commission hold a public hearing at the next meeting for all of the Ordinance changes. Eugene Stoeckel seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

New Business

Eugene Stoeckel motioned to approve the outdoor event for Long Siding Bar & Grill. John Roxbury, Jr. seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

John Roxbury, Jr. motioned to approve the new Ditch Mowing Contract with Sanford Farms. Mark Riverblood seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Eugene Stoeckel motioned to approve the first half of the 2014 Fire Contract in the amount of \$23,795.00. John Roxbury, Jr. seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Mark Riverblood motioned to approve the Town Hall Payment in the amount of \$10,750.00. John Roxbury, Jr. seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Township Engineer Report

Todd McLouth gave an update on the culvert issue from the previous months' meeting. He stated that the only time there were issues was when the culvert was plugged with dirt by the homeowner. Now that it is exposed again, it needs to be finished with topsoil and sod to prevent further erosion.

After some discussion, Nancy Moan, the homeowner, agreed that they would do the necessary work to restore the culvert to the way it was before it was plugged.

Todd McLouth stated that he got the bids back from the Route Crack & Seal project, and Allied was the low bidder. The areas are Sunrise Addition, North Preserve of Princeton and Rolling Meadows.

Mark Riverblood motioned to award the bid of contract to Allied Blacktopping. John Roxbury, Jr. seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Todd McLouth gave an update on 110th Ave, where the road washed out. He suggested a couple of different options to avoid problems in the future.

After some discussion Todd stated that he would call the Conservation office to see if they have any information on the area.

Open Forum

Ed Botzek wanted to know what could be done with 33rd Street because he said it is in bad shape. Mark Riverblood stated that they may want to look at some gravel in that area. Greg Anderson stated that they may be able to look at some gravel sometime in the fall.

Supervisor's Reports

Eugene Stoeckel gave an update on the Airport Advisory Board.

Jim Kusler gave an update on the City of Princeton Planning Commission.

Mark Riverblood gave an update on the 4R Board.

Greg Anderson stated that he was contacted by Dennis Haubensheid because he is looking at purchasing some property in Section 26 and would like to have the area rezoned from Rural Residential to Agricultural. Mark Riverblood and John Roxbury, Jr. agreed that would be a good area to look at rezoning.

Greg Anderson stated that there were several culverts that needed to be installed since the last meeting; two on 40th Street and one on 50th Street. The roads were washed out and flooding homes. Brian Dahlheimer fixed both of the areas.

Mr. Anderson also stated that there was a resident who thought a culvert was taken out on 50th and County Rd 1 when the County did work in the area, and therefore water was backing up and flooding her basement. The Board did not think there was ever a culvert on that road and the Clerk stated that she had a call into the County to see if they removed one.

Clerks Business

The Clerk stated that the Township has a CD with Bremer Bank that is up for renewal. John Roxbury, Jr. motioned to renew the CD. Eugene Stoeckel seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Approve Payment of the Bills

A motion was made by John Roxbury, Jr. and seconded by Jim Kusler to approve payment of the bills, Check numbers 10449-10481. Motion Carried.

Adjourn

A motion was made by John Roxbury, Jr. and seconded by Eugene Stoeckel to adjourn the meeting at 8:19 p.m. Motion Carried.
