

On Tuesday, October 21, 2014 at 7:30 p.m. Town Board Chairperson Greg Anderson called the regular monthly Town Board meeting to order. Other Supervisors present were Eugene Stoeckel, Jim Kusler, John Roxbury, Jr. and Mark Riverblood.

### **Approve Minutes**

A motion was made by John Roxbury, Jr and seconded by Eugene Stoeckel to approve the minutes of the September 16, 2014 regular monthly meeting as printed. Motion Carried.

### **Approve Financial Report**

A motion was made by John Roxbury, Jr and seconded by Eugene Stoeckel to approve the Financial Report for September 2014 as submitted. Beginning Balance of Township funds was \$435,288.18; total receipts of \$2,033.77; total disbursements of \$7,587.42; leaving a balance of \$429,734.53. Motion Carried Unanimously.

### **Old Business**

There was no old business on the agenda.

### **New Business**

John Roxbury, Jr. motioned to approve a land split for George and Carl Sanford, Section 20. Eugene Stoeckel seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

### **Open Forum**

Larry Ziebarth stated that the Ordinances for simple plats only apply to the R-1 zone and would like to know if the Town Board would like the Planning Commission to look into the issue to see if it would make sense to use simple plats in all of the Residential zones. The Board agreed to have the Planning Commission look into it.

Carol Carling gave an update on the Princeton Visionary Committee.

Carol Carling wanted to thank the Clerk for being so organized and detailed with the upcoming elections.

There was a school student who wanted to know what was wrong with the wood carver sign. Mr. Anderson explained that it does not meet the County or Township ordinances because of the location and size.

The student also asked what the Coborns grant was for. Carol Carling explained how the grant pertained to the Princeton Area Visionary Committee.

### **Supervisor's Reports**

John Roxbury, Jr. informed the Supervisors that the Mille Lacs Soil and Water is looking for input and has posted a survey on their website.

Eugene Stoeckel gave an update on the Fire and Airport Advisory Board.

Jim Kusler gave an update on the City of Princeton Planning Commission.

Mark Riverblood asked the Clerk if there was any response to the sign that the wood carver put up. The Clerk informed him that the sign does not belong to Joe Semler, but instead Larry Doose. The Clerk explained that another letter was sent out addressed to Mr. Doose informing him that he needs to remove the sign per Ordinance.

Mark Riverblood asked the Town Board if they would consider moving the meeting time to 7:00 p.m. instead of 7:30 p.m. Greg Anderson stated they should all think about it and discuss it at the next meeting.

Mark Riverblood stated that he had a resident ask him what was happening with Balsam Road and the new school issue. He told them that the Township was investigating it with the School District about improvements for the long term. John Roxbury, Jr. stated that based on the School District meeting he attended, there were no plans of running traffic from the new school north. All the traffic will go south.

**Clerks Business**

The Clerk stated that she talked to Rick Johnson from West Branch Const. and was told that he has a car counter and would be willing to let the Township use it, and would even set it up for us.

The Clerk stated that she drove by the residence with the culvert issue and it appears that they are correcting the problem. It was re-graded and there was black dirt brought in.

The Clerk stated that she received a price for 4 tires for the road grader from Glens tire in Mora, in the amount of \$6,5350.00. That also included installation and disposal. John Roxbury, Jr. motioned to have the new tires installed. Eugene Stoeckel seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

**Approve Payment of the Bills**

A motion was made by Eugene Stoeckel and seconded by John Roxbury, Jr. to approve payment of the bills, Check numbers 10571-10603. Motion Carried.
