

On Tuesday, February 16, 2016 at 7:30 p.m. Town Board Chair Greg Anderson called the regular monthly Town Board meeting to order. Other Supervisors present were Jim Kusler, Eugene Stoeckel, Mark Riverblood and John Roxbury, Jr.

Approve Minutes

A motion was made by Eugene Stoeckel and seconded by John Roxbury, Jr. to approve the minutes of the January 19, 2016 regular monthly meeting as printed. Motion Carried.

Approve Financial Report

A motion was made by John Roxbury, Jr. and seconded by Mark Riverblood to approve the Financial Report for January 2016 as submitted. Beginning Balance of Township funds was \$657,982.94; total receipts of \$4,416.32; total disbursements of \$38,484.34; leaving a balance of \$623,914.92. Motion Carried Unanimously.

Old Business

John Roxbury, Jr. stated that the Planning Commission members discussed having a member serve as a liaison on the City of Princeton PC but they wanted more clarification on when the meetings were each month. He explained that there was no one who volunteered and they decided to table the issue until the next meeting.

New Business

Open Forum

There were no residents present to speak.

Supervisor's Reports

Jim Kusler gave an update on the City of Princeton's Planning Commission.

Mark Riverblood stated that he has not had time to go over Greenbush's Subdivision Ordinances again and compare them to ours, but he stills intends to, as soon as he can.

Mark Riverblood stated that he was upset with an untimely notification from the County regarding a public hearing notice.

Greg Anderson stated that the Township attorney is involved in fighting the annexation with the City of Princeton for the Jane Odgers property. He stated that Ms. Odgers is also opposed to it. Mr. Anderson stated that the City is going about it the wrong way and using the wrong statute.

Greg Anderson stated that Eric Minks turned in his resignation for the Planning Commission. The Board agreed to publish for the position. The Clerk stated that there was already a notice that was going to be publicized.

Clerks Business

The Clerk stated that she had a complaint about the outdoor lighting at the Beaudry location. Several board members stated that they didn't think it was any worse than any other businesses. Mr. Riverblood stated that he would look into it.

The Clerk asked the Board who they would like to use for Clean Up Day. Mr. Anderson stated that he did not think there would be a problem using Brian Dahlheimer again, after last year. The Board agreed to ask Brian if he was interested and if he wasn't, then the Clerk could look for someone else.

The Clerk reminded the Supervisors about the Board of Audit.

The Clerk asked about cutting the trees on 40th St. The Board agreed to have Mr. Riverblood get in touch with the property owner and figure out what needs to be done.

Approve Payment of the Bills

A motion was made by John Roxbury, Jr. and seconded by Eugene Stoeckel to approve payment of the bills, Check numbers 11087-11123. Motion Carried.
