

On Tuesday, August 16, 2016 at 7:30 p.m. Town Board Chair Greg Anderson called the regular monthly Town Board meeting to order. Other Supervisors present were Eugene Stoeckel, Jim Kusler, Mark Riverblood and John Roxbury, Jr.

Approve Minutes

A motion was made by Eugene Stoeckel and seconded by Mark Riverblood to approve the minutes of the July 19, 2016 regular monthly meeting as printed. Motion Carried.

Approve Financial Report

A motion was made by John Roxbury, Jr. and seconded by Jim Kusler to approve the Financial Report for July 2016 as submitted. Beginning Balance of Township funds was \$513,912.70; total receipts of \$184,660.21; total disbursements of \$48,942.82; leaving a balance of \$649,630.09. Motion Carried Unanimously.

Old Business

There was no old business on the agenda.

New Business

John Roxbury, Jr. motioned to approve the Liquor License for the new owners of Princeton Lanes & Lounge. Eugene Stoeckel seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Open Forum

There were no residents present.

Supervisor's Reports

John Roxbury, Jr. gave an update on the City of Princeton's Planning Commission.

Eugene Stoeckel gave an update on the Fire & Airport Advisory Board.

Eugene Stoeckel stated that he contacted West Branch Construction regarding County Line Road and was informed that as long as the township is not filling any wetlands, we should not need any special permitting. Eugene stated that West Branch was also interested in doing the job which could entail grinding up 2-3 miles of blacktop and therefore be considerable less than resurfacing the road.

Mark Riverblood stated that he would be in favor of passing a resolution asking the County to take over the road, therefore ensuring they would look into the request. John Roxbury, Jr. stated that he would talk to Bruce Cochran regarding the issue.

Greg Anderson stated that when 52nd Ave was redone by the Township a few years back and ditches were put in, we removed a field driveway but never replaced it. Now the property owner, Tim Wilhelm, has put in two crops but does not have any access to those fields. Mr. Anderson explained that he had the Clerk contact West Branch Const. to see how much it would cost to have a new field driveway put in and was informed that it would cost \$2700.

John Roxbury, Jr. motioned to approve having West Branch Construction install a new driveway to replace the one that was removed by the Township. Eugene Stoeckel seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Clerks Business

The Clerk had nothing to report.

Approve Payment of the Bills

A motion was made by Eugene Stoeckel and seconded by John Roxbury, Jr. to approve payment of the bills, Check numbers 11319-11353. Motion Carried.

Adjourn

A motion was made by John Roxbury, Jr. and seconded by Eugene Stoeckel to adjourn the meeting at 7:47 p.m. Motion Carried.
