

On Tuesday, September 20, 2016 at 7:30 p.m. Town Board Chair Greg Anderson called the regular monthly Town Board meeting to order. Other Supervisors present were Eugene Stoeckel and John Roxbury, Jr. Supervisors Jim Kusler and Mark Riverblood were absent.

Approve Minutes

A motion was made by Eugene Stoeckel and seconded by John Roxbury, Jr. to approve the minutes of the August 16, 2016 regular monthly meeting as printed. Motion Carried.

Approve Financial Report

A motion was made by John Roxbury, Jr. and seconded by Eugene Stoeckel to approve the Financial Report for August 2016 as submitted. Beginning Balance of Township funds was \$649,630.09; total receipts of \$7,674.88; total disbursements of \$29,084.11; leaving a balance of \$628,220.86. Motion Carried Unanimously.

Old Business

There was no old business on the agenda.

New Business

The Clerk explained that she had received several complaints on the speed limits on 56th Ave. and when she researched the issue, discovered that the speed limit could be changed from 55 mph to 35 mph through a Resolution, rather than having MNDOT perform a speed study.

The Board agreed to discuss the issue again at the next monthly board meeting since there was not a full board present.

Open Forum

There were no residents present.

Supervisor's Reports

John Roxbury, Jr. notified the Board that someone was cleaning up the property with the burned up buildings.

John Roxbury, Jr. gave an update on the City of Princeton's Planning Commission.

Eugene Stoeckel gave an update on the Fire & Airport Advisory Board.

Greg Anderson explained the Zion Lutheran has been in several times to inquire about an addition onto the Church, however they want to build in the setbacks. They have inquired about a variance and were informed that there is no hardship in order to grant one. They have a public hearing at the next Planning Commission meeting for a CUP.

Clerks Business

The Clerk notified the Board that the Strunge hearing that was scheduled for Sept. 22nd was rescheduled for a later date.

The Clerk stated that she spoke with Pat Oman from the County regarding the recycling contract. She informed him that there were some errors and was sent a revised copy. The Board reviewed the contract and agreed that it looked right and told the Clerk to proceed with the County.

Approve Payment of the Bills

A motion was made by John Roxbury, Jr. and seconded by Eugene Stoeckel to approve payment of the bills, Check numbers 11354-11380. Motion Carried.
