

On Tuesday, October 17, 2017 at 7:30 p.m. Town Board Chair Greg Anderson called the regular monthly Town Board meeting to order. Other Supervisors present were Eugene Stoeckel, Mark Riverblood, Jim Kusler and Larry Ziebarth.

Approve Minutes

A motion was made by Larry Ziebarth and seconded by Eugene Stoeckel to approve the minutes of the September 19, 2017 regular monthly meeting as printed. Motion Carried.

Approve Financial Report

A motion was made by Larry Ziebarth and seconded by Eugene Stoeckel to approve the Financial Report for September 2017 as submitted. Beginning Balance of Township funds was \$772,458.11; total receipts of \$4,803.16; total disbursements of \$43,070.50; leaving a balance of \$734,190.77. Motion Carried Unanimously.

There was no old business on the agenda.

New Business

There was no new business on the agenda.

Open Forum

Tony Erholtz, Mille Lacs County Deputy, gave an update of what is happening in the Township.

Michelle Anderberg stated that Joanne Larson, Carl Sanfords' daughter, had an overabundance of little dogs at her residence and she was upset that Ms. Larson did not come in and get a kennel permit, especially since she is the daughter of someone that sits on the Planning Commission.

Deputy Erholtz stated that there is an ongoing investigation with the Sheriff's Department and they are aware of what is happening, however he could not give any further details.

Chairman Anderson stated that if she is running a 'puppy mill' or has excess dogs, she would need to come in and get a Conditional Use Permit and follow certain criteria. He asked to Clerk to get Loren Kohnen, the Zoning Administrator, involved.

Michelle Anderberg stated that she was concerned because Carl Sanford is on the Planning Commission and she feels that this situation raised a trust issue between him and the Township.

Supervisors Report

Eugene Stoeckel gave an update on the Airport Advisory Board.

Larry Ziebarth gave an update on the Fire Advisory Board.

Clerks Business

The Clerk stated that she checked into that 10 acre parcel, owned by Susan Kettleholdt (previously owned by Wayne & Marcy Patten) that Eugene Stoeckel questioned last month and the parcel was split legally and does have enough road frontage.

Approve Payment of the Bills

A motion was made by Eugene Stoeckel and seconded by Jim Kusler to approve payment of the bills, Check numbers 11771-11793. Motion Carried.

A motion was made by Larry Ziebarth and seconded by Eugene Stoeckel to adjourn the meeting at 7:45 p.m. Motion Carried.
