The Clerk asked for nominations for a moderator. A motion was made by Joanne Kusler and seconded by Marcia Anderson to nominate Jim Kusler. Motion Carried.

A motion was made by Mark Riverblood and seconded by Joanne Kusler to approve the minutes of the 2017 Annual Meeting as printed. Motion Carried.

Larry Ziebarth motioned to amend the agenda to allow for the Princeton Fire Dept. to give an update. Eugene Stoeckel seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Tim Jansen, from the Princeton Fire Dept., gave an update on what was happening in the City and Township, and gave a brief overview of the past years activities.

A motion was made by Mark Riverblood and seconded by Joanne Kusler to approve the 2017 Financial Report as follows: Cash balance beginning January 1, 2017 was \$709,165.57; total receipts of \$426,508.15; total disbursements of \$395,562.09; Cash balance on December 31, 2017, was \$740,111.63. Motion Carried Unanimously.

A motion was made by Eugene Stoeckel and seconded by Mark Riverblood to appoint everyone as their own pound master. Motion Carried.

Greg Anderson gave a road report for the past year.
