

On Tuesday, April 17, 2018 at 7:30 p.m. Town Board Chair Eugene Stoeckel called the regular monthly Town Board meeting to order. Other Supervisors present were Greg Anderson, Jim Kusler and Thomas Duden.

Approve Minutes

A motion was made by Jim Kusler and seconded by Greg Anderson to approve the minutes of the March 27, 2018 regular monthly meeting as printed. Motion Carried.

Approve Financial Report

A motion was made by Jim Kusler and seconded by Thomas Duden to approve the Financial Report for March 2018 as submitted. Beginning Balance of Township funds was \$719,502.61; total receipts of \$33,667.19; total disbursements of \$26,165.68; leaving a balance of \$727,004.12. Motion Carried Unanimously.

Old Business

Mr. Anderson stated that since there was a full house tonight, they may need a full board to make a vote, he made a motion to appoint Mark Riverblood as a Supervisor to fill the vacancy because of Larry Ziebarth's resignation. Eugene Stoeckel stated that the procedure is to advertise the position. Mr. Anderson said that was not correct. Tom Duden stated that Parliamentary Procedure states that the President abstains from a vote. Mr. Anderson stated that they do not have Parliamentary Procedure in place at the Township and it has never been accepted. Eugene Stoeckel stated that according to Minnesota Association of Townships, the Township has to advertise the position before they can appoint. Mr. Anderson stated that according to State Statute, the Board needs to appoint someone. Mr. Stoeckel stated that according to the information he got from MAT, they needed to advertise. Jim Kusler seconded the motion to appoint Mark Riverblood to fulfill the open position of Township Supervisor. Thomas Duden asked if they could take nominations from the floor. Mr. Anderson stated that the action needs to come from the Board. Mr. Stoeckel indicated that a vote would be taken. Mr. Duden asked if he could still throw out a name. Mr. Stoeckel stated that a motion has been made and seconded and that the Clerk also has a vote. Motion Carried with Jim Kusler, Greg Anderson and Connie Wubben in favor and Thomas Duden opposed. Mr. Riverblood was sworn in as Town Board Supervisor.

New Business

The first item on the agenda was the road issue on 82nd Ave. and 33rd St. After much discussion, Mark Riverblood motioned to have the engineer prepare an estimate and describe in detail what the scope of work would be and also the fee for a feasibility study so it could be discussed at the May meeting. Thomas Duden seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Jim Kusler motioned to correct Resolution 2018-2 to read 2018-3. Thomas Duden seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Thomas Duden motioned to approve the Liquor License for Moonshine Bar & Grill. Greg Anderson seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Greg Anderson motioned to approve the Liquor License for Shooters. Jim Kusler seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Thomas Duden motioned to approve the Liquor License for Princeton Lanes & Lounge. Jim Kusler seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Thomas Duden motioned to approve the Liquor License for Old Log Liquor. Greg Anderson seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Thomas Duden motioned to approve the Liquor License for Long Siding Bar & Grill. Greg Anderson seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Open Forum

Roxanne Hayes stated that she is not happy with the snow plowing that is done on her road. Jim Kusler stated that since they are now aware of it, corrective action can be taken.

David Patten wanted to know the process for splitting a lot. Mark Riverblood stated that he could review the information with the Clerk after the meeting.

Michelle Anderberg was concerned about why the Chairman was replaced. She was also concerned about all of the posts on facebook from Mr. Duden for the Township.

Scott Moller wanted to know the process about rezoning a property from Residential to Agricultural. He was told to get all of the information and application from the Clerk during business hours.

Supervisors Report

Greg Anderson wanted to know if the Board wanted to rent out the mowing equipment to a neighboring township. Thomas Duden stated that a fair price would be in the \$55 an hour price range to rent out the equipment with no operator or fuel. Thomas Duden motioned to charge \$60 an hour to rent out the tractor, plus fuel, plus labor, for a neighboring township. Mark Riverblood seconded the motion with a friendly amendment that Princeton Township's roads and ditches come first. Thomas Duden added the amendment to his motion. Motion Carried.

John Roxbury, Jr. stated that the other township needs to make sure that their own insurance covers the equipment.

Eric Minks stated that Board is discussing items that were not on the agenda. Greg Anderson stated that he was just following up on an item that was at last months' meeting.

Eugene Stoeckel gave an update on the Airport Advisory Committee.

Clerks Business

The Clerk reminded the Board about the upcoming clean-up day and Board of Review.

Approve Payment of the Bills

A motion was made by Jim Kusler and seconded by Greg Anderson to approve payment of the bills, Check numbers 11967-11999. Motion Carried.

Adjourn

A motion was made by Greg Anderson and seconded by Jim Kusler to adjourn the meeting at 9:02 p.m. Motion Carried.
